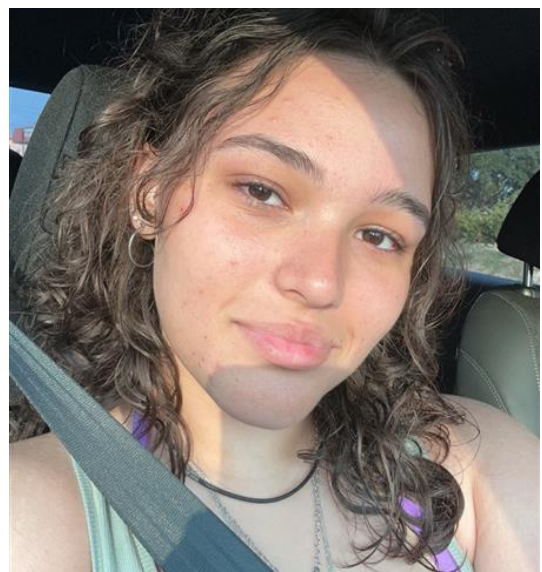
PASADENA PARADE
